

NOTICE OF ELECTION

UK Parliamentary Election for the Woking Borough Constituency

1. An Election is to be held for a Member of Parliament to serve the Woking Borough Constituency.
2. Forms of nomination for the Parliamentary election may be obtained at the Civic Offices, Gloucester Square, Woking, Surrey, GU21 6YL from the (Acting) Returning Officer who will, at the request of an elector for any electoral area prepare a nomination paper for signature.
3. Nomination papers must be delivered to the (Acting) Returning Officer, Civic Offices, Gloucester Square, Woking, Surrey, GU21 6YL on any day after the date of this notice (excluding Bank Holidays and weekends) between the hours of **10am and 4pm** but no later than **4pm on Friday 7 June 2024**.
4. The required deposit of £500 may be made either by legal tender, by means of a banker's draft or by the electronic transfer of funds.
5. If the election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday 4 July 2024**.
6. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **12 midnight on Tuesday 18 June 2024**. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>

Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes (including postal proxy votes) must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Civic Offices, Gloucester Square, Woking, Surrey, GU21 6YL by **5pm on Wednesday 19 June 2024**. 8. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm on Wednesday 26 June 2024**.
