What has happened

The stabilisation works underneath the school building have been completed. This now allows us to begin construction of the concrete slab which will form the foundation of the school.

Aside from this, work on the drainage for the car park area at the front of site has begun. This will be situated beneath the car park area to ensure that all the water leaves site in the correct manner via the new drainage system.

Various utilities have also been connected into site from the roadway in order to service the site in the future. For any upcoming works in the road, we will notify you in advance.



What happens next

The drainage and utilities will continue to be installed around site by our ground workers. These will go into the car park linking into the drainage for the new building.

The ground floor slab of the first section will be prepared for concrete at the beginning of November. This will allow our steelwork contractor to bring in the frame to erect the remainder of the structure.

Work by our high voltage contractor has been completed in the north of site and the next section of their work will continue in the south of site. A letter drop has been carried out to all properties where there could be disruption. Once again we apologise for any inconvenience this may cause.



Other News

We were delighted to host a visit for some students from Hoe Valley school, to show them how the construction phase is progressing. One student from each form group came along to hear about the work to date and see the site for themselves. They took notes and photos and will be using those to provide an update to the other students in their form groups when they return to school.
