

WOKING BOROUGH COUNCIL (COMMERCIAL WAY - SECTION BETWEEN CHOBHAM ROAD AND 5 HARLAND HOUSE. **COMMERCIAL WAY) (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) ORDER 2020**

Notice of a proposal to make a temporary traffic regulation order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and regulation 3 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Procedure Regulations 1992 (SI 1992/1215)

1. WOKING BOROUGH COUNCIL as agent for SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL (being the Highway Authority) gives notice that it proposes to

make an Order under section 14(1) of the RTRA 1984 and any other enabling powers over (i) an area of the highway being Commercial Way, section between Chobham Road and 5 Harland House in Commercial Way. Woking shown RED on the plan attached to the Order ("Plan").

2. The Order will close one part of an area of the highway known as Commercial Way shown coloured RED on the Plan.

The Order is needed to facilitate resurfacing of part of Commercial Way using block paving to match the paving used within the town centre.

If the Order is made, the Order shall come into operation on 8 October 2020 starting at 12.01am for a period of 3 months.

The Order will restrict vehicular access to a section of Commercial Way, Woking, shown in RED on the Plan.

No alternative access route will be available for use to exit Commercial Way while the Order is in force.

The deliveries to businesses will be serviced through Chobham Road section, shown by the BLUE.

8. Access for pedestrians will be maintained at all times. 9. A copy of the draft Order and Plan may be inspected at the public notice board outside the main entrance to Woking Borough Council,
