



## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS ACT 1984 – SECTION 14

### WOKING BOROUGH COUNCIL (CHERTSEY ROAD - SECTION BETWEEN CHOBHAM ROAD and THE BROADWAY) (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) ORDER 2021

**Notice of a temporary traffic regulation order made under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and regulation 3 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Procedure Regulations 1992 (SI 1992/1215)**

- WOKING BOROUGH COUNCIL as agent for SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL (being the Highway Authority)** gives notice that it has made an Order under section 14(1) of the RTRA 1984 and any other enabling powers over (i) an area of the highway being Chertsey Road, section between Chobham Road and The Broadway, Woking shown BLUE on the plan attached to the Order ("Plan").
- The Order has
  - closed one part of an area of the highway known as Chertsey Road shown coloured BLUE on the Plan
  - imposed temporary traffic light shown RED on the Plan
  - imposed temporary two way traffic along the section of Chertsey Road between Chobham Road and Dukes Street shown coloured YELLOW on the plan.
- The Order is needed to facilitate resurfacing of part of Chertsey Road using block paving to match the paving already used within the town centre.
- The Order came into operation on 4 January 2021 starting at 10am and will remain in place for a period of 8 weeks.
- The Order has restricted vehicular access to a section of Chertsey Road, Woking, shown in BLUE on the Plan.
- An alternative access route is available for use to access and exit Chertsey Road and Chobham Road while the Order is in force. The access route is as follows: from The Broadway turn right into Locke Way, turn left into Dukes Street, and turn right into Chertsey Road / Chobham Road shown GREEN on the Plan.
- Access for pedestrians will be maintained at all times.
- A copy of the draft Order and Plan may be inspected at the public notice board outside the main entrance to Woking Borough Council, Civic Offices, Gloucester Square, Woking, Surrey GU21 6YL from 21 December 2020 for a period of 6 months.
