

WOKING BOROUGH COUNCIL (CHOBHAM ROAD - SECTION BETWEEN COMMERCIAL WAY AND JUNCTION WITH CHERTSEY ROAD) (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) ORDER 2020

- Notice of a proposal to make a temporary traffic regulation order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (RTRA 1984) and regulation 3 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Procedure Regulations 1992 (SI 1992/1215)
- 1. WOKING BOROUGH COUNCIL as agent for SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL (being the Highway Authority) gives notice that it has made an Order under section 14(1) of the RTRA 1984 and any other enabling powers over (i) an area of the highway being Chobham Road, section between Commercial Way and junction with Chertsey Road, Woking shown RED on the plan attached to the Order ("Plan").
- 2. The Order has closed one part of an area of the highway known as Chobham Road coloured RED on the Plan.
- 3. The Order is required to facilitate resurfacing of part of Chobham Road using block paving to match the paving used within the town centre.
- 4. The Order came into operation on 2 November 2020 starting at 12.01am and will be in place for a period of 3 months.
- 5. The Order will restrict vehicular access to a section of Chobham Road, Woking, shown in RED on the Plan.
- 6. No alternative access route will be available for use to exit Commercial Way while the Order is in force.
- 7. Deliveries to businesses will be serviced through Chertsey Road shown by the BLUE and Church Path shown by the GREEN section.
- 8. Access for pedestrians will be maintained at all times.
- 9. A copy of the draft Order and Plan may be inspected at the public notice board outside the main entrance to Woking Borough Council, Civic Offices, Gloucester Square, Woking, Surrey GU21 6YL from 19 October 2020 for a period of 6 months. A copy may also be viewed by visiting www.woking.gov.uk
