## Procedure Regulations 1992 (SI 1992/1215) WOKING BOROUGH COUNCIL

- WOKING BOROUGH COUNCIL as agent for SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL (being the Highway Authority) gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under section 14(1) of the RTRA 1984 and any other enabling powers over an area of the highway being Church Street
- East, Woking shown RED on the plan attached to the Order ("Plan").
- 2. The Order will close one part of an area of the highway known as Church Street East shown coloured RED on the Plan.
- The Order is needed to facilitate the resurfacing of part of Church Street East using block paying to match the paying used within the town
- centre
- - The Order will take effect from 7pm 25 October 2019 to 6am Monday 28 October 2019.
- The Order will restrict vehicular access to Christchurch Way, Church Path, and Chobham Road Woking, shown in YELLOW on the Plan,
