

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATONS ACT 1984 - SECTION 14** WOKING BOROUGH COUNCIL (CHURCH STREET EAST No.2) (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) ORDER 2019

NOTICE of a proposal to make a temporary traffic regulation order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and regulation 3 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Procedure Regulations 1992 (SI 1992/1215)

WOKING BOROUGH COUNCIL as agent for SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL (being the Highway Authority) gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under section 14(1) of the RTRA 1984 and any other enabling powers over an area of the highway being Church Street East. Woking shown red on the plan attached to the Order ("Plan").

2. The Order will close one part of an area of the highway known as Church Street East shown coloured red on the Plan; and

The Order is needed to facilitate resurfacing of part of Church Street East using block paving to match the paving used within the town centre.

If the Order is made, the Order shall come into operation on:

7pm, Friday 16 August to 6am, Monday 19 August (carry out paving).

The Order will restrict vehicular access to Christ Church Way. Church Path, and Chobham Road Woking, shown in vellow on the Plan, for the above mentioned dates and hours.

No alternative access route will be available for use while the Order is in force. 6.
